

## Rural & Northern Education Funding (RNEF)

Starting in 2017, the Ministry of Education allocated funding to CDSBEO to further improve education for students from rural communities. Funds were allocated to school boards based on the number of rural students and two factors measuring the density of rural student enrolment in the board.

CDSBEO was able to spend at schools where at least half of the school's students are from rural communities. CDSBEO could use the funding for rural education based on local needs such as:

- Improving programming and support services in rural schools;
- Continuing the operation of rural schools; or
- Enhancing student transportation options
