5. Reading Intervention & Supporting Student Gains Presentation – *Lorrie Doing & Julia Fortin, CDSBEO Reading Intervention Teachers*

The Reading Intervention Teachers discussed how their experiences with UFLI, Structured Literacy, Teacher Training, Small Group Intervention, and last year's progress data, alongside PPM 168, will enhance their Reading Intervention support for the 2024-25 school year. Starting in September 2024, all 27 CDSBEO elementary schools will implement the Acadience Screener. K-6 teachers participated in a workshop at the end of the 2023-24 school year to familiarize themselves with the Acadience Screener. This Fall, two Reading Intervention Teachers will visit each school to further support staff in facilitating the Acadience Reading Screener and reading intervention.

Family and Children's Services of Lanark, Leeds and Grenville – Tom Jordan Three University of Ottawa Faculty of Education Students will be working with Family and Children's Services of LLG and supporting the PAWS program.

Child and Youth Mental Health Services, Cornwall Community Hospital – Susie Trotter A reminder that the Cornwall Youth Hub is available for children aged 12 and older. They are continuing to host their "Chill Night" every Wednesday.

7. Special Education Department Update – Angie McNamee, Principal of Special Education Superintendent Brent Bovaird is now overseeing Special Education, succeeding Heather Gerber, who will overseeing several different portfolios. The department is grateful for her leadership which spans the past 7 years. The department welcomes back the secondary SCLCs, SSWs, and the Mental Health team under the Special Education umbrella. New appointments include Sandy O'Doherty as Lead Registered Behaviour Analyst and Brooke Lapierre as an Intensive Support Worker for the Cornwall area. More staff hires are anticipated this Fall.

The ABA team and ICT department have developed a new online Behavior Management System training series via Vector, which will include online theory and in-person physical sections this Fall.
