2. Association Updates

<u>Rural FASD Support Network – Tracy Mertz</u>

- October 2024 Summary
 - October Caregivers Meeting featured Jessica Danielle, a communicative disorder assistant at Wellington Kids and Shannon Butt who presented on her Anchor Program. The Anchor Program is aimed at youth with FASD transitioning into adulthood to our Youth Group. Shannon will continue to present her program to our youth for the next several months alongside the Caregiver Meetings.
- November 2024 Update
 - November Caregivers Meeting will feature co-speakers Ryan Billing and Carrie Onstein from Career Services of Brockville. Our monthly Caregiver Meetings have on-site childcare and are held on the third Saturday of each month at 7 Beech Street in Smiths Falls.
 - November 14th Virtual session of Mental Heath First Aid Training. The training was very successful with individuals, people from Rideau Community Health Services, people from Algonquin College and people from Quinte Health participated
 - Through the Lanark County Situation Table, Rural FASD responded to recent local events with a Community Safety Planning Table.
 - Rural FASD is in the planning stages of several 2025 events around FASD awareness and fundraising.

3. Department Update – Angie McNamee, Principal of Special Education

- The Mini Courses Program (MCP) will return at the end of May 2025, offering around 70 Grade 8-11 students the chance to engage in a week-long program of their choice at either, the University of Ottawa or Carleton University. We plan to begin the initial stages of this initiative by January 2025.
- The head psychologist of CDSBEO is conducting Mental Health First Aid training for all administrators over the next two months. This training is designed to enhance mental health literacy and equip participants with the skills and knowledge needed to assist others in managing potential or emerging mental health issues.

CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL Board of Eastern Ontario

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- In response to the recommendations from the Ontario Human Rights Commission, the Special Education department will be conducting an IEP audit at each school. The focus will be on ensuring that instructional intervention planning and implementation play a central role in advancing students' learning.
- The Special Education, Math, and Curriculum departments have collaborated to launch the Leaps and Bounds Math intervention program, along with a tier 2/3 Corrective Reading program, in all schools. Administrators, SERTs, and classroom teachers will receive training in the coming months.
- These are exciting initiatives as we are following the same model with the Structured Literacy -UFLI intervention program. CDSBEO is ensuring our students have the intervention programming necessary to move forward successfully.
