

WE NEED YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

- * **Parents are responsible for providing this information.**
- * Health care providers do not automatically send immunization information to the Health Unit.
- * Students attending school or daycare in Ontario must be immunized according to the Publicly Funded Immunization Schedule for Ontario*.
- * We do not need proof of their COVID immunizations.

3 ways you can provide your child's immunization records to the Health Unit:

1. Health Unit website: for daycare children or students in JK/SK that have not sent in any previous immunization records yet. Health Card number is very helpful, but not required.



2. ICON web portal: can be used if you have previously submitted immunization records for that child. You will need your child's health card to log in. You are able to see what we already have on file and upload a picture of any additional vaccination records.



3. Drop off or Mail to any office of the Health Unit:
