

CDSBEO Multi-Year Strategic Plan 2025-2030

Director of Education Laurie Corrigan presented the draft CDSBEO Multi-Year Strategic Plan for 2025-2030, to the Board of Trustees. Director Corrigan introduced and provided an overview of the plan, emphasizing its roots in extensive consultations with stakeholders, inspired by Pope Francis's synodal approach. This approach fostered inclusivity, deep listening, and reflection, ensuring the diverse voices of parents, students, staff, and community members, shaped its direction.

The new strategic plan builds on the successes of the 2020 plan and revolves around four key pillars: **To Belong, To Believe, To Nurture, and To Learn**. These pillars aim to foster inclusive communities, deepen faith, create safe and supportive environments, and improve student achievement through evidence-based approaches. Key elements include the integration of Catholic social teaching, a renewed focus on mental health and well-being, and leveraging resources such as tiered approaches to learning and technology. The plan also highlights the importance of belonging, framing it as essential to fostering meaningful participation and representation across the school board. The presentation underscored the plan's commitment to improving student learning conditions by promoting critical thinking, creativity, and holistic development.

Trustees approved the draft plan and commended the inclusive process and clarity of the presentation. Insights from the Strategic Plan Advisory Committee were also acknowledged. The meeting concluded with appreciation for the collaborative efforts of schools, staff, and the community in shaping a vision that reflects shared faith and values for the next five years.
